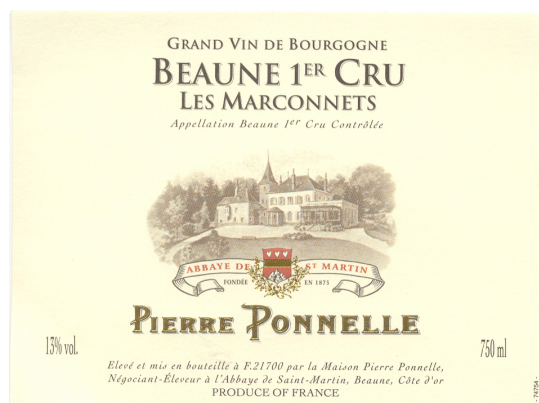


BEAUNE 1ER CRU “LES MARCONNETS”



TERROIR

Beaune, the capital for burgundy wines is also the largest appellation of the Côte d'Or region. Beaune vineyards are one of the vineyards to have the biggest percentage of 1er Cru. Beaune 1er Cru "Les Marconnets" is 9Ha large.

TASTING

Very dark red color. Elegant and powerful bouquet, with red fruit aromas such as blueberry. This wine has a elegant structure and the tannins are spicy. It has red and black fruit aromas like blackberry.

Grilled poultry, roasted beef with mushroom, duck with peach sauce, great with burgundy cheeses.
